

Syllable Sort

A fun way to help your learner segment words into syllables



- Collect objects, small toys, fruits, vegetables from around the home.
- Use four bowls, baskets, containers, or different parts of a table top - label the baskets 1, 2, 3, 4 (for the number of syllables).
- Discuss the objects and what they are.
- Work with your child to sort the objects into whether the word for the object has 1, 2, 3, or 4 syllables.
- [Ways to extend](#) - can your learner identify the vowel in each syllable, can they choose the correct letters to spell the syllable, can they put the syllables together to spell the word?
