Syllable Sort

A fun way to help your learner segment words into syllables



- Collect objects, small toys, fruits, vegetables from around the home.
- Use four bowls, baskets, containers, or different parts of a table top - label the baskets 1, 2, 3, 4 (for the number of syllables).
- Discuss the objects and what they are.
- Work with your child to sort the objects into whether the word for the object has 1, 2, 3, or 4 syllables.
- Ways to extend can your learner identify the vowel in each syllable, can they choose the correct letters to spell the syllable, can they put the syllables together to spell the word?
