Irregular words can not be sounded out - we have to memorise them. Take a look at our mnemonics section for ideas to support this.

Firstly - here is a list of the 30 most frequently occurring irregular sight words (in their order of frequency).
Below this you will find the same list broken into 5 tables of 6 words - to allow you to break the task down
The smaller lists can be cut into cards to use as simple flash cards or, if you make 2 copies, in games such as pairs and snaps which are a useful and fun way to provide repeated sighting/ reading of the words - to support memory.
